Class Descriptions

Arts & Crafts: Children will explore a wide range of creative, design activities that are related to making things, objects, and showpiece items. They will use a variety of mediums and do textile, paper, decorative, and functional crafts.

Bubbles, Beakers, & Bible: Draw the Bible from simple and fun science experiments! What do electric pickles, homemade snow, and slime have to do with the Bible? PLENTY. We will explore a variety of scientific experiments that are sometimes strange, sometimes quirky and always fun Kids love to watch surprises unfold before their eyes.

Puppets: Acting, story creation, puppet manipulation and play. Children will explore their creative side through the use of puppets.

Woodworking: Children assemble projects in wood, using simple tools and techniques. We'll emphasize safety in our explorations, and the pleasure of making things.

Ceramics: We will paint on ready-made Ceramic Bisque Tiles, small figurines, and Create with Air Dry Clay.

Handbells: Playing handbells is a great way to foster the development of strong rhythmic skills, physical coordination, and listening skills. It's also an effective way to teach the basics of music-reading (direction, reading lines and spaces) and provide children with an active way to play and make music together.

Creative Writing: This class will help develop the process and techniques of creative writing and storytelling.

Origami: Students will learn the elementary level of origami, the art of paper-folding. Students will explore traditional origami which consists of folding a single sheet of square paper.

Painting: Explore the world of canvas painting with acrylics and pastels.

Photography: Explore Photography Composition. What makes a great picture? Learn the different composition guidelines that will help you enhance the impact of your photos.

Drama: Explore the world of drama through speech, dramatic movement, improvisation, and skits.

Culinary: Explore the world of food.

Gardening: Learn and grow through gardening.

Maker-Spaces: Taught by our local public library. Students will blend physical and digital worlds through programming, coding, and building circuits. This class will encourage the creative side as well as build critical thinking, problem solving, sequencing, and programming skills.
