

ACV Coronavirus Update March 30

President Trump has extended the social distancing order until April 30, encouraging Americans to continue to limit travel and gatherings of 10 people or more. Therefore, we have canceled all ACV events of 10 or more through that date. This includes the birthday party, membership association meeting, Whipple and Morales artist series event and the volunteer appreciation reception. The Village Wide Yard sale planned for May 2nd is also canceled. Copeland Community Center will remain closed and all bus trips outside of Dowling Park are canceled as well. Worship services will continue to be only available by broadcast on TV2 and Facebook Live.

Campus facilities will also remain closed to non-members during this time and all dining will be takeout. Members can still take advantage of pre-ordering takeout meals for the next day by calling (386) 658-5933 or select meal options at Rumph Dining Room or Lopin Gopher Deli during normal hours. The Village Grocer and Village Pharmacy will continue delivery services. Contact them directly. For the prescription pickup service for off campus pharmacies that do not deliver, call 658-5933. Copeland Medical Center remains open to all patients, but anyone with a fever or COVID 19 symptoms must call before entering the building.

Three Suwannee County residents have tested positive for COVID-19. None of these are ACV residents, however, the virus is getting closer to Dowling Park so we strongly urge members to continue to follow the guidelines that have been put in place by the CDC and federal and state health officials.

The greatest risk continues to be from a member or employee who has had contact with someone who has the virus but does not yet realize it. We encourage all residents to stay on campus unless it is an emergency and to discourage visits from out of town guests and family. Maintain a distance of six feet from others and wash hands often. Remember, we are in this together and it takes each of us working together for the protection of the community.
