

ACV Coronavirus Update April 1

ACV administrators continue to monitor closely the directives and advice from health officials. Current national projections are for the situation to worsen over the next couple of weeks, so we continue to urge all members to follow the guidelines provided. Avoid visits and travel, maintain social distancing, wash hands often and avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.

Today Florida Governor DeSantis issued a Stay at Home order starting Thursday at midnight for the next 30 days affecting all non-essential businesses in the state. ACV is exempted from this as an essential business and will not be forced to shut down. The order will limit what individuals can do however. We will give more information on this in tomorrow's update.

We strongly urge Village members not to travel off campus. If you must have contact with people outside of ACV, please follow the CDC's directives. If you do travel off campus overnight you must be screened by your Service Coordinator prior to returning to campus and once you arrive back you must be screened at the IC and have your temperature taken prior to returning to your residence.

We ask you to discourage visitors from coming. If you must have a visitor make sure he/she does not have any symptoms that would prohibit them from being on campus. First, call your Service Coordinator for screening and if approved, have them go to the Information Center for further screening and a visitor badge prior to visiting your residence.

For members who live in Dowling House, Carter House, Smith Riverview Apartments, or Lawrence House and who must receive critical supplies from family, we ask that you meet your family outside the exterior door and that they do not enter the building unless authorized in advance by your Service Coordinator. Any visitor coming to the campus for any reason must be screened at the Information Center before going to any residences.

Questions they will be asked include:

- Do you have a Cough?
- Shortness of breath?
- Any other symptoms of respiratory infection?
- Fever greater than 100 degrees F?
- Have you knowingly been in contact with someone who has or is under investigation for Covid-19?
- Within the last 14 days, have you:
 - ❖ Traveled on a cruise ship
 - ❖ Traveled by airplane (domestic or international)
- Please provide travel dates & itinerary
- Have you visited any area with state or local government-issued Stay-At-Home order due to Covid-19, including California, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Louisiana, and south Florida (Miami-Dade, Broward, or Palm Beach counties)?

➤ Where & when Visited?

There are now four Suwannee County residents who have tested positive for COVID-19. The virus is getting closer to Dowling Park so we strongly urge you to continue to help us keep the Coronavirus out of Advent Christian Village by following the recommendations.
