

Coronavirus Update, November 27

At Good Samaritan Center, we currently are not aware of any residents or staff members out because of Coronavirus. A Dacier Manor resident contracted the virus in the hospital and will remain away from the facility until cleared. We are not aware of any cases among the employees at Dacier Manor.

We are also not aware of any new employees in independent living with Covid-19. The test of an employee out because of symptoms came back negative. One employee remains isolated because of a previous case.

We are aware of two new cases among the membership in independent living as well as the one previously reported case. All three of these individuals are isolated and will remain that way until cleared by health officials.

The virus remains prevalent in the communities around us so everyone continues to be encouraged to follow the guidelines in place. Wear a mask, maintain appropriate distances and follow good hygiene practices.

Since our last report, there have been 54 new cases in Suwannee County, for a total of 3,235 cases of COVID-19 in Suwannee County since March.

As we now make preparations for the Christmas season, please be assured that our goal is to have a meaningful celebration of this special holiday while also limiting risk.
