

## **Coronavirus Update, Friday, April 2**

Since our last update, we have learned that an independent living member has tested positive for Covid-19. Contact tracing is occurring and the individual will remain isolated until cleared by health officials. Moreover, an employee in independent living is out awaiting the results of a test after having contact with a known case. They will not be able to return to work until cleared by health officials. The two cases are not related.

There are no known cases of the virus among the members or staff at Dacier Manor or Good Samaritan Center.

Policies and practices for visitation at Good Samaritan Center and Dacier Manor continue to change, so families are asked to contact administration in these facilities for updates.

With these new cases, please be reminded that the virus remains active on campus and in the surrounding community. Since our last update, there have been 17 new reported cases in Suwannee County for a total number since last March of 5,222

Beginning this week, both non-ACV members and ACV members are invited to attend worship services at the Village Church. Distancing and mask requirements remain in effect. Likewise, there is a cap of 200 participants. Overflow seating will be available in the chapel.

While we are easing restrictions, be reminded that most Village Facilities remain closed to nonmembers. Likewise, when out you are encouraged to wear a mask, maintain appropriate distances and follow good hygiene practices. Again, now is not the time to let your guard down as progress is being made.
